Enroll by February 13 to ensure access to UC Davis systems, including Time Reporting and AggieTravel. Duo is the new multifactor authentication security technology being implemented at UC ANR, UC Davis and many other campuses.

If you receive paper paychecks, it is important to make sure your home address is correct by February 27 since you will receive your paycheck by mail. Paper paychecks are sent by the U.S. Postal Service and will arrive *after* payday.
